#### DOE Rules

Develops rule makings for 10 CFR Part 830, *Nuclear Safety Management*

#### Nuclear Policy Interpretations

Provides clarification for specific applications of the requirements in DOE orders, rules, and other directives

#### Readiness Review

Keeps the Operational Readiness and Readiness Review communities abreast of the latest related news, issues, and events

#### Technical Standards Program

Promotes the use of voluntary consensus standards at DOE, DOE's efforts to develop and maintain necessary technical standards, and Communicates information on technical standards activities to DOE

#### Fire Protection Program

Establishes and maintains the DOE requirements for fire protection programs

#### Training Policy

Develops training rules, Orders, technical standards, and handbooks related to the selection, qualification, and training of nuclear facility personnel

#### Criticality Safety

Establishes and maintains the DOE requirements for nuclear criticality safety

#### Safety Basis Information System (SBIS)

Supports the Nuclear Safety Management Rule (10 CFR 830) requirements for DOE contractors and operators

#### Risk Assessment Technical Experts Working Group

Supports appropriate use of risk assessments in nuclear safety applications

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
