Get up to a \$35 Rebate

Recycle that old working refrigerator or freezer. If it's over 10 years old, it could be using up to three times more energy than newer models. We'll pick it up and pay you \$35.

Recycle that old working room air conditioner that just blows tepid air. We'll pick it up and pay you \$25.

Don't Trash It - Recycle It

Refrigerators and freezers have components that can be hazardous or toxic. Don't just throw them out with the regular trash, arrange a pickup and have them recycled safely.

How to Get Your Rebate

You must be a Pacific Gas and Electric Company (PG&E) electric customer

The recycled refrigerator must be residential grade, commercial refrigerators do not qualify

 $Your\ refrigerator\ or\ freezer\ must\ be\ 10\ to\ 32\ cubic\ feet\ in\ size,\ empty\ and\ operational\ at\ the\ time\ of\ pickup$

There is a limit of two refrigerators or freezers per customer, per year. Only one room A/C unit per customer, per year

Room AC units will only be picked up in conjunction with the pickup of an eligible refrigerator or freezer at the same location, except for special drop-off events. These events will be in partnership with retailers that sell ENERGY $STAR^{\otimes}$ room AC units

Contact JACO Environmental, PG&E's recycling partner for a pickup

Allow approximately six to eight weeks after the pickup for PG&E to send you a check in the amount of \$35 for each refrigerator or freezer, and \$25 for each room AC

Click on the Rebate Pickup tab at the top of the page, and then follow the instructions

You will be asked for your PG&E Electric Service ID number and residence zip code. Electric Service ID is listed on your PG&E bill under the section titled *Electric Account Detail*. See below:



If you are eligible, JACO will schedule your pickup date and time
