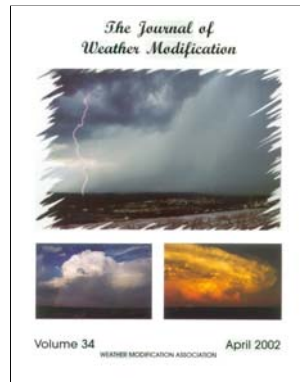

The deadline for papers submitted for publication in the reviewed section of Volume 42 is December 19, 2009, and the deadline for notes and correspondence is January 15, 2010. Publication is expected by the end of March, hopefully in time for distribution at the upcoming annual meeting at Santa Fe, New Mexico.
