**Weather Modification Advisory Committee**

The Weather Modification Advisory Committee consists of five members who assist the TDLR staff in evaluating applications for Texas weather modification licenses and permits. The Committee was first established with enactment of the Texas Weather Modification Act of 1967. Members are appointed by the Texas Commission on Licensing and Regulation and represent diverse geographic and professional interests within Texas.

The Committee conducts public meetings on a quarterly basis to consider various weather modification concerns. Members do not receive any honorarium.
